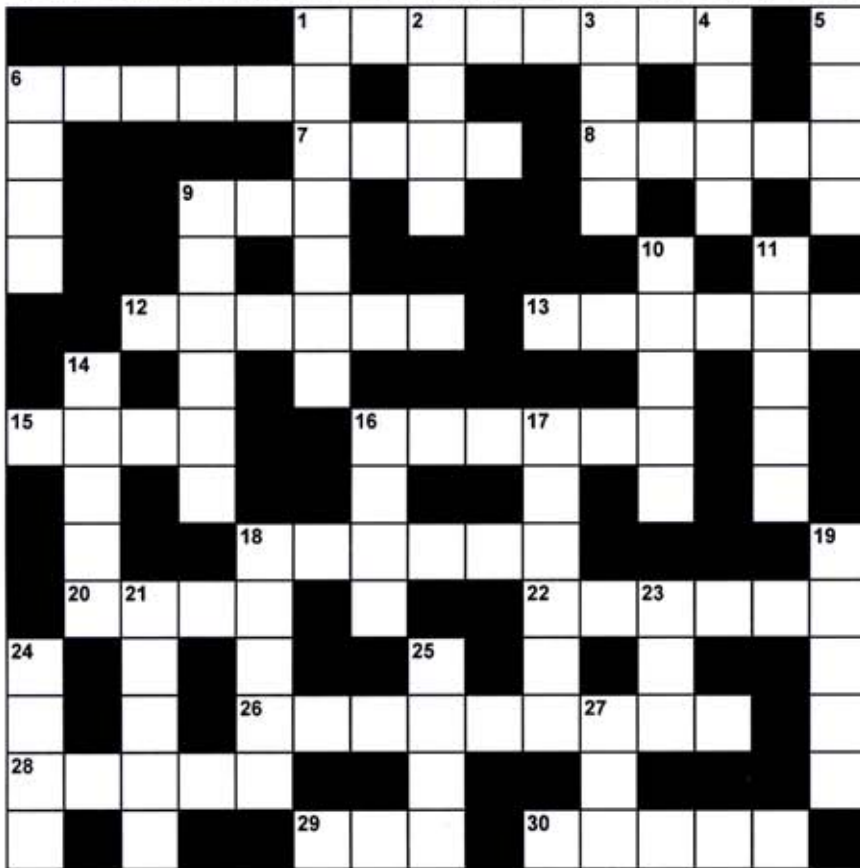


Hard and soft C (a) (Bk 2)

The letter **C** is soft when followed by **E, I** or **Y** e.g. **cellar, pace, cinder, city** and **cycle**. It is hard when followed by any other vowel e.g. **cap, collar, and curve** or any other letter (including another **C**) e.g. **occur, neck, cloud, crisp** and **act**. It is also hard when



found on its own at the end of words with more than one syllable e.g. **panic, rhythmic, electric, sonic, zodiac** and **maniac**,
