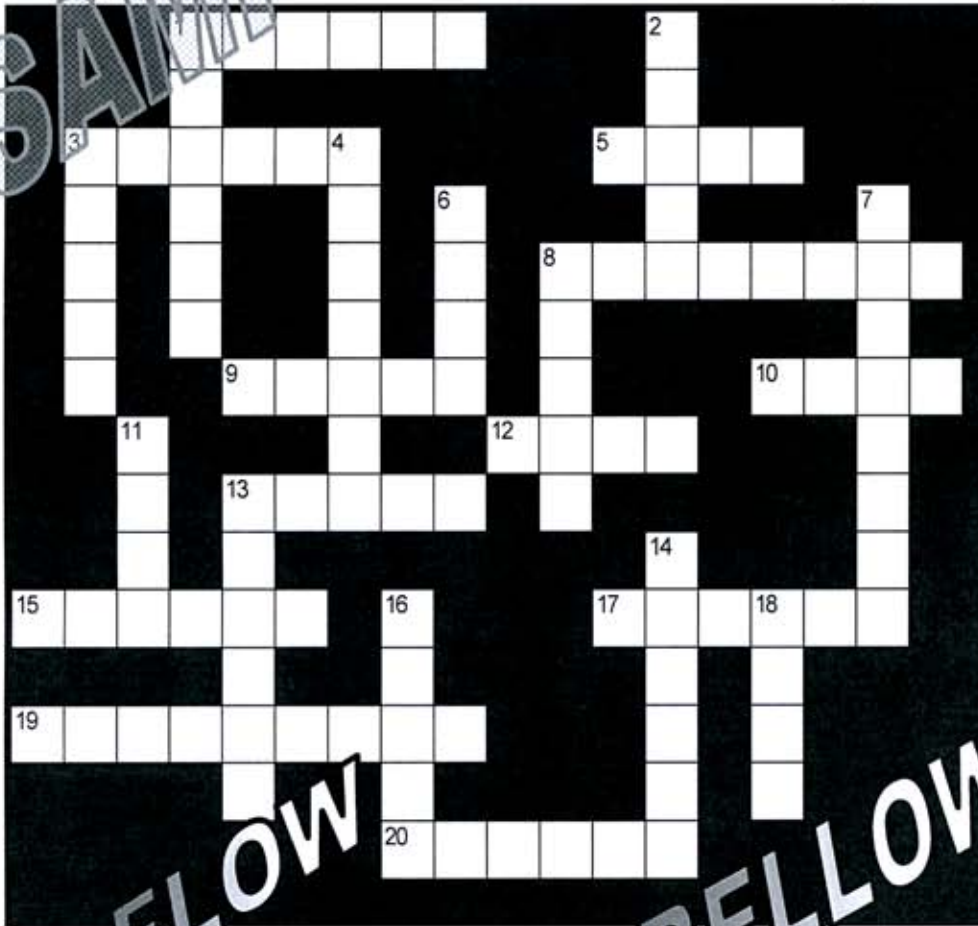


Words with OW (a) (Bk 4)
